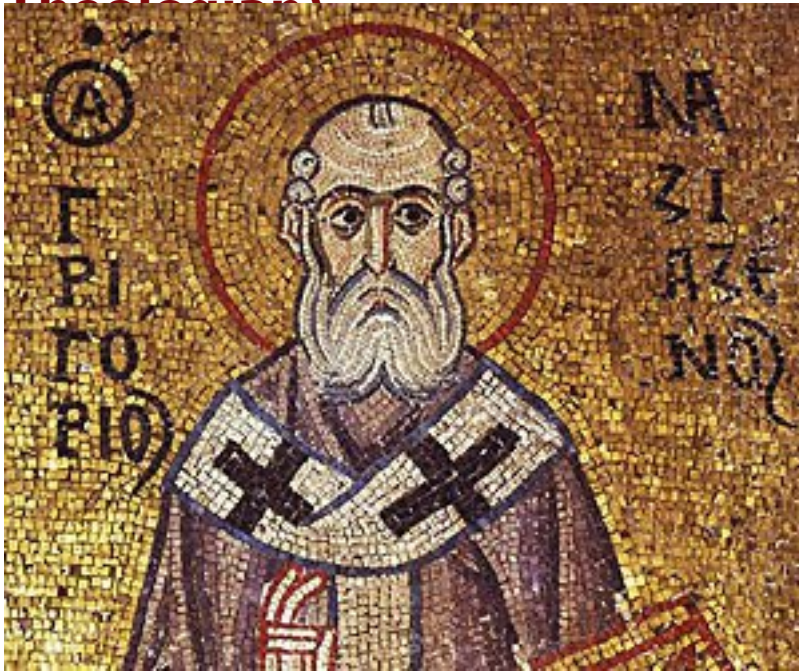


A “thank you, God” present (Saint Gregory the Theologian)
